



Cooking party information

The minimum age for cooking parties is year 3 (birthday child to be 8)

I can adjust to cook most things your child fancies but parties generally are as follows-

- Cook a meal eg pizza including base or fresh home made pasta and sauces and garlic bread or something similar. Pizza is the most popular choice and works really well.
- Decorate cakes with lots of different icings etc, piping cream etc.
- The birthday child I gets to decorate own bday cake too.
- Decorate cake boxes
- The children will eat the tea that they cook and take home some cakes in lovely cake boxes,
- There is time for eating tea, cutting cake etc

The cost for a 2.5 hour all inclusive party as above is £300 for up to 10 children,

I can accommodate two more if necessary at £25 extra per child.

It can be in my home or yours but I prefer mine as I have everything we need here.

I can also sort party bags with food/cooking related gifts for £8 per bag.

I ask for half the money at time of booking and half payable on the day of party.

I will need you to fill in details of the kids coming and confirm any food allergies they have at least a week before the party.

You are welcome to stay for the party but you don't need to if you would rather not! I have teenage girl helpers who will be here to help out.
